The University of South Alabama's School of Computing will award scholarships in the range of \$500 to \$5,000 to incoming freshmen entering USA in the Fall semester and pursuing a degree in, Computer Science, Information Systems, Information Technology, Health Informatics, or Cyber Assurance. Students that begin as a general studies student in Computing will also be eligible for these scholarships.

These awards are generated from the School's endowed funds and included the following scholarships:

Application Instructions:

Students wishing to apply for one of these scholarships must provide the following two items:

1. Typed or printed, completed application.
 2. An official high school transcript (including 1st semester senior grades with SAT/ACT scores). This transcript must be sent by the guidance counselor or principal to the same address as application and postmarked by May 1

Criteria:

Successful candidates must be first time freshmen, admitted as an undergraduate student at USA, and have a composite ACT score of at least 24.

All qualified students will be considered for these awards. The award amount will be determined by the ACT score and GPA. Current school activities and accomplishments as well as leadership may also be considered.

Scholarship recipients should attend a summer orientation session and be advised by a SoC advisor during that visit. The scholarship will be declared void if the student fails to take appropriate course work as advised by a School of Computing advisor.
